What is Jefferson Christian Collegiate Academy?

- Jefferson Christian Collegiate Academy is an initiative between York College and Jefferson Christian Academy to offer an online Associate of Arts (AA) for motivated students who want to kick-start their college careers.
- Jefferson Christian Collegiate Academy's Associate Degree is designed to be completed over two years. To participate, students must be sophomores or rising juniors.
- By following the specified course plan, students receive an accredited Associate in Arts (AA) degree from York College, which includes 60 hours of transferable college credit and may also be used toward one of the university's four-year undergraduate degrees.
- Jefferson Christian Collegiate Academy courses are offered online and include all course materials, instruction, technology, and support.
- The first course is College Readiness, designed to prepare students for college-level courses.

How does it work?

- Students enroll in Jefferson Christian Collegiate Academy directly through their high school.
- Students can begin their coursework as early as the spring of their sophomore year.
- Courses are mapped to the high school curriculum, so students meet the requirements for graduation while completing college-level courses.
- Each three-hour course in the Collegiate Academy is \$200, which includes all course materials, technology, course instruction, and enrollment fees. Participating students or schools are billed each semester for the courses they take.
- Students will complete a total of 60 hours in the degree program, taking four courses in the Fall and Spring semesters and two each Summer.
